Air Force ROTC is a college program offered at more than 1000 campuses across the country that prepares young men and women to become leaders in the U.S. Air Force. You will grow as an individual both mentally and physically while developing lifelong friendships. You will acquire strong leadership skills. And you will have the opportunity to pay for school through scholarships. Plus unlike many college students, you'll have a position waiting for you after graduation at one of the top high-tech organizations in the world — the Air Force.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Because a lot is expected from students in Air Force ROTC, there are certain admission requirements:

- **Maintain a 2.0 GPA** (2.5 if on scholarship)
- **Attend a college that offers AFROTC.**
- **Enroll in AFROTC as an elective.**
- **Be in good physical shape.**
- **Have high moral character.**

SERVICE

If you continue beyond your second year in AFROTC or are a recipient of a full or partial scholarship, you agree to serve in the U.S. Air Force following graduation with an opportunity to enter as an officer. And if grad school is in your plans, you may be eligible for tuition assistance to help you pursue your graduate degree once you join the Air Force.

OFFICERSHIP

After completing the AFROTC program and graduating from college, you'll join the Air Force as an officer with the opportunity to lead others in your career field. As an officer, you can expect an excellent starting salary, plus additional allowances, as well as free medical and dental insurance, 30 days of vacation a year and a substantial retirement plan.

SCHOLARSHIP OPTIONS

Air Force ROTC can help you with the rising costs of college education with an array of full or partial scholarships that cover tuition and books and even provide extra spending money so you can concentrate on your studies instead of how to pay for them.
